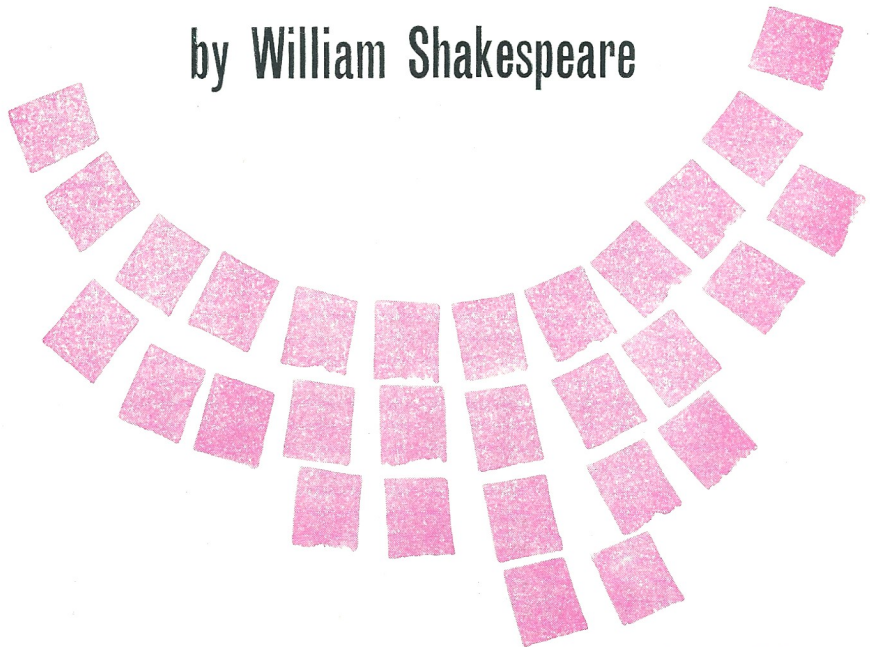


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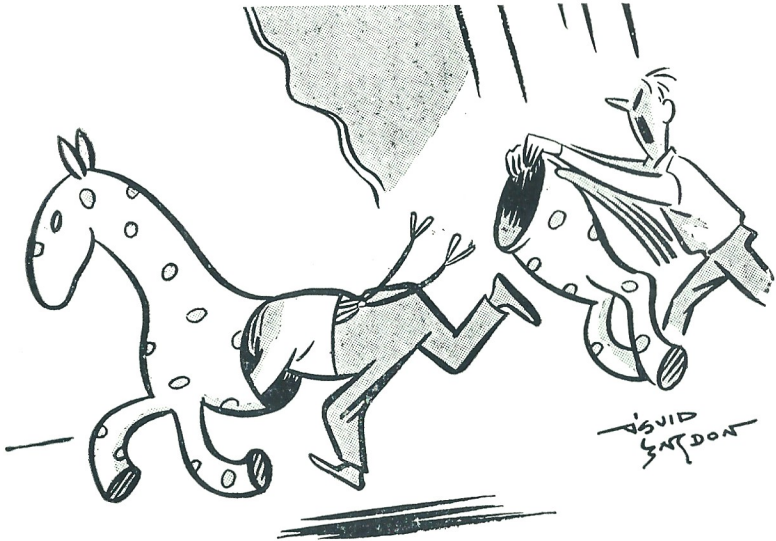

- (e) to make use of the licensed bar facilities adjacent to the Theatre (on payment of a small additional subscription).

JOINT CLUB MEMBERSHIP is available to husband and wife at the reduced rate of £2 10s. per annum, plus only 10s. entrance fee.

If you live beyond twenty-five miles from The Questors Theatre you may become a COUNTRY ASSOCIATE MEMBER for 10s. a year plus 10s. entrance fee. COUNTRY ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP entitles you to purchase seats at the Theatre, and enjoy other privileges of membership.

Those under eighteen years of age may enjoy the same privileges as a Club Member by becoming JUNIOR MEMBERS at only 15s. per annum.

(ACTING MEMBERSHIP is subject to audition, and enquiries should be made to the Theatre Manager.)

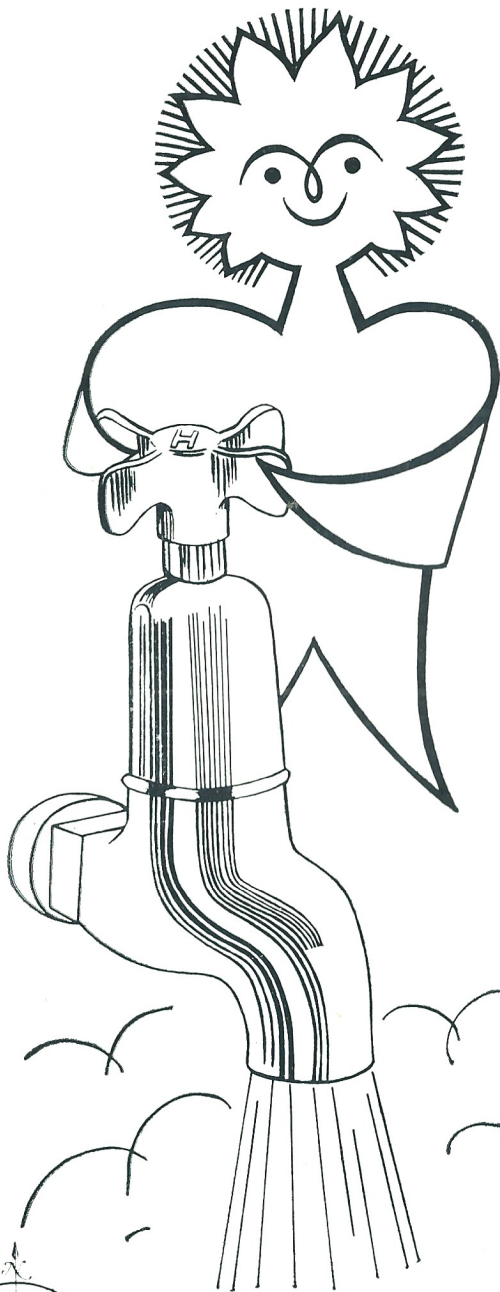
