The Student Group

The Questors Student Group commenced in 1946 and is intended for amateurs who are seriously interested in the theatre and is primarily, but by no means exclusively, aimed at training actors and actresses for the main acting group of The Questors Theatre. Enrolments are accepted for one year initially and admission to the Second Year Group is by selection. The course is run by The Questors Theatre, on behalf of and under the auspices of the Middlesex County Council Education Committee, in conjunction with the Ealing Technical College. Students have the unique advantage of being closely associated with a working theatre under the general direction of Alfred Emmet who also takes the Acting Classes with the First Year Group. Many of the classes are held on the stage of the theatre, and the theatre background is always present. Conducted in close association with the main work of The Questors Theatre, in which students are encouraged to participate, opportunities are provided to help with the technical work of the Theatre's main productions, and for occasional Group attendance at rehearsals.

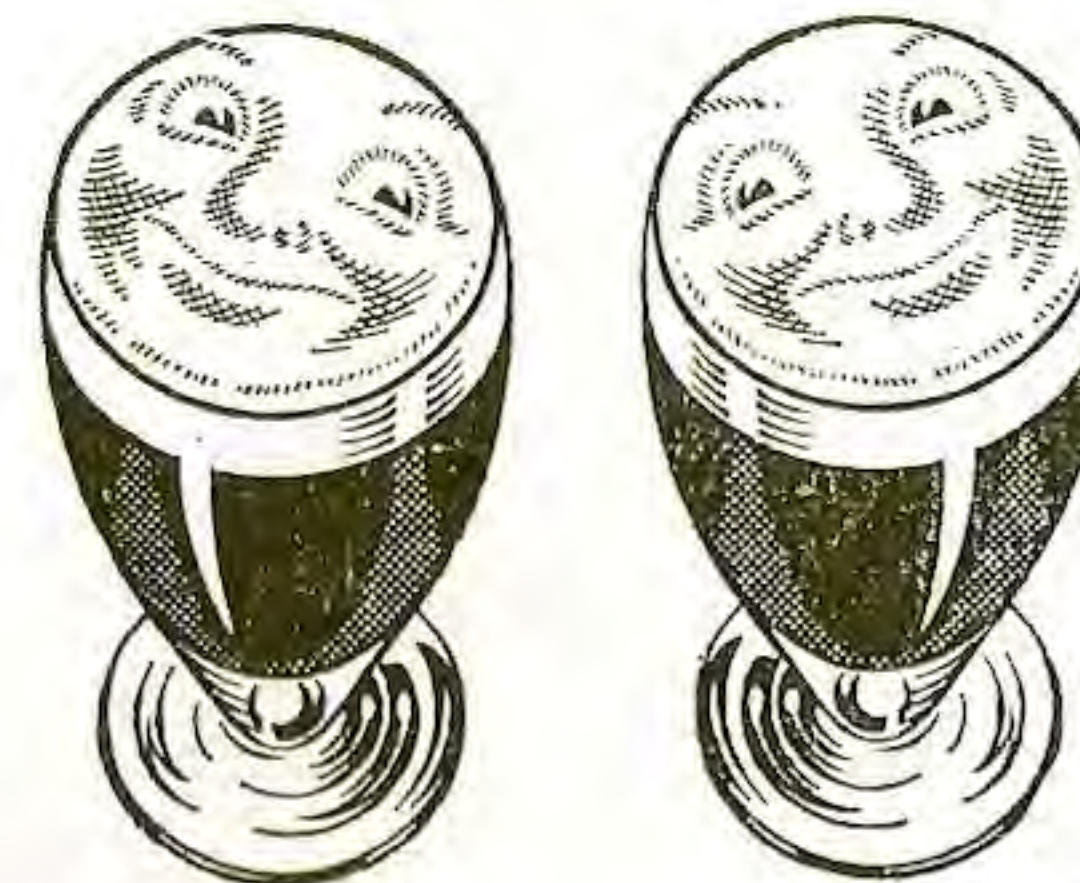

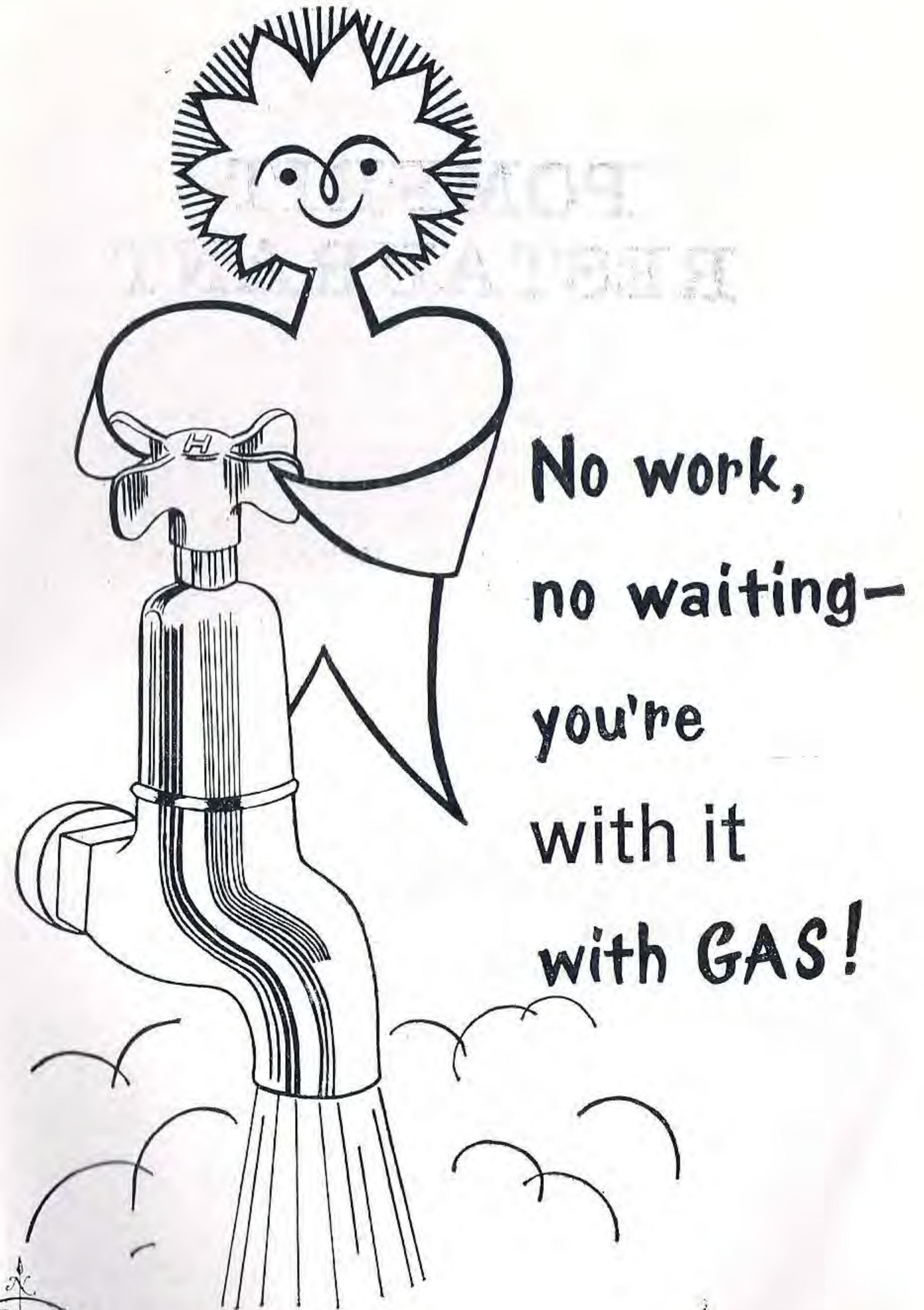
