Saturday, 7th October, 1972

Today some of the obvious instances of inequality between the sexes are no longer with us. However, many of the more profound questions of relationship between man and woman are still a cause for conflict. The lies apparent in the relationship between Nora and Helmer in "A Doll's House", are still part of our lives. In seeing in depth the predicament of the participants of the play, we can examine our own.

Nora has been seen in the past as a symbol of all women longing to open the door into life. The entry into a wider experience of life is part of a theme which fundamentally questions the concept of the bourgeois home. Usen feels that the man and woman partnership is possible when there is mutual respect for one another underlined by an understanding of the motives behind our actions.

The play is not a doctrinaire piece, but rather an examination of the reasons we play certain roles in our middle-class society. It questions what happens when a woman finds that her individual morality comes into conflict with her belief in authority.
