JULIUS CAESAR

The events of this play represent the last positive actions carried out in the name of the Roman Republic. Julius Caesar was the latest in a line of military Politicians who had challenged the authority of the Senate and ruthlessly seized power in their own names. Caesar's power was supreme for only a few years from his defeat of Pompey until his death in 44BC. This political volatility continued then for 18 years until Octavius Caesar, the last character to speak in Shakespeare's play, became the Emperor Augustus. The Roman Empire, which was to last almost 1,500 years, had begun.
