The characters in this play are Sydney Carlyle Cockerell, Director of the Fitzwilliam museum at Cambridge; George Bernard Shaw, critic and playwright; and Dame Laurentia McLachlan, Benedictine nun and later Abbess of Stanbrook Abbey in Worcestershire.

Sydney Cockerell introduced Shaw to Dame Laurentia in 1924. She was then 58, Shaw 68 and Cockerell 57.

Each character is shown at home - Cockerell in the sitting room of his house in Kew, Shaw in his study at Ayot-St-Lawrence and Dame Laurentia at Stanbrook.
