

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

A friend had her attention attracted by a man in a Porsche as they negotiated Chiswick roundabout - he was holding up a centrefold of a naked woman, and inviting my friend to have sex. Threatening from a safe place, but how many women do you know who have been sexually assaulted, anything from being touched up in the tube to rape? Ask around, every woman has a story.

The recent Dispatches programme om BBC2 investigated the possibility of a connection between pornography and violence against women, but came to no firm conclusion.

Sarah Daniels wrote this play in 1983 when the first "snuff" movie was sold here. It is still possible to buy this and similar films, if you know where to look.

"Masterpieces" is set in London. The events take place over 12 months in 1991 and 1992 and shift back and forth throughout the year.
