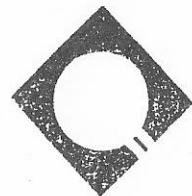

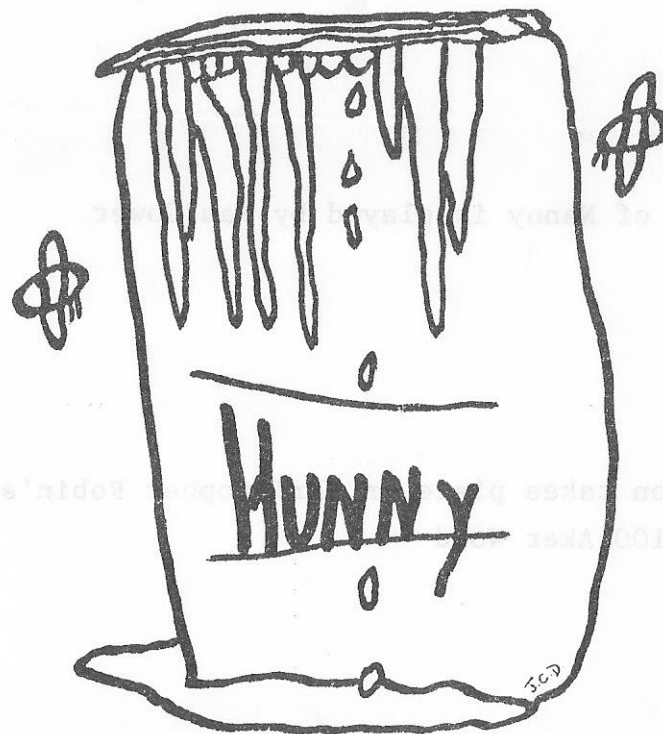
'Winnie-the-Pooh' Drawing Competition
