

Biscuits4friends

75g/3oz butter
75g/3oz caster sugar
1 egg
Few drops of vanilla essence
150g/6oz plain flour
Jam or fruit curd

Preheat oven to 180°F

Cream the butter and sugar together, then beat in the egg and add the vanilla essence. Gradually stir in the flour. Knead well and roll out to ½ inch thick. Cut out an even number of round biscuit shapes. Cut a small circle out of the centre of half of them. Spread them all out on a lightly greased baking tray and bake for 10-15 minutes. When they are cool, sandwich them together with jam, lemon curd or another filling of your choice.







