## **Biographies**

Margot Scannell comes from County Cork and has lived in London for 15 years. She trained at Birmingham School of Acting and has since acted professionally in England and Ireland. Productions include Edward If (UK Tour), Educating Rita, Female Transport. Agnes of God, Nunsense, Blithe Spirit, Sharon's Grave and Arsenic and Old Lace. Margol joined The Questors two years ago and this is her first performance here.

Sarah Keller was at The Questors 15 years ago in Student Group 49, appearing in Here Comes a Chopper and The Suicide. She later trained with the Actors' Company. Stage productions include The Typists, The Voysey Inheritance, A Chaste Maid in Cheapside, Three Sisters, The Pillars of Society and A Doll's House. Sarah rejoined The Questors a year ago, and this is her first production as an acting member.

David Emmet has directed 48 productions at The Questors since 1978, and Contractions is his 49th. The most recent have been Three Sisters, Further Than the Furthest Thing and the double bill of After Magnitle and Black Comedy. His 50th production will be Titus Andronicus in May 2011. David is also an occasional actor and stage manager, and Director of Studies for the Student Group.

Mike Bartlett (Author) is one of the leading new writers on the British Stage. His first play, My Child, was seen at the Royal Court in 2007. Contractions followed in 2008 and Cock in 2009. He has also written Artefacts for the Bush (2008), and his most recent play, Earthquakes in London, was seen at the National Theatre earlier this autumn.
