Erma Bombeck was an American woman born into the Silent Generation who found her voice in the 1960s and 70s, writing a daily column that was syndicated in 900 papers across America and read by 30 million people, where she wrote humorous articles about the unequal dynamics of traditional gender roles from the

perspective of a suburban housewife. Women related to her in a way they couldn't with feminists such as Gloria Steinem and Betty Friedan. She was a best-selling author, appeared on The Tonight Show with Johnny Carson, as well as regular spots on Good Morning America. She also wrote and produced her own TV sitcom, Maggie.
