Director's Introduction

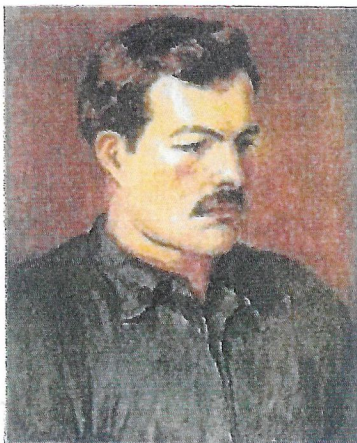
Hemmingway in Barcelona is a new piece of writing based on a real event – the murder of Jose Robels in 1937 – and the fallout this caused between Earnest Hemingway and John Dos Passos. The characters in the play are a mix of real and fictional, allowing us to explore not just the events leading up to the murder, but some of the wider issues at play in Spain at the time.

The play is set in the bar of the Hotel Continental in Barcelona – Christmas 1937. Act I takes place late one evening around Christmas itself, and Act II takes place on New Years Eve and the following morning.
