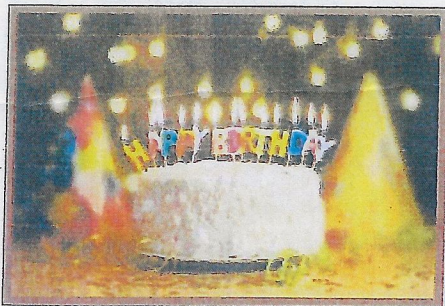


**The Pact**

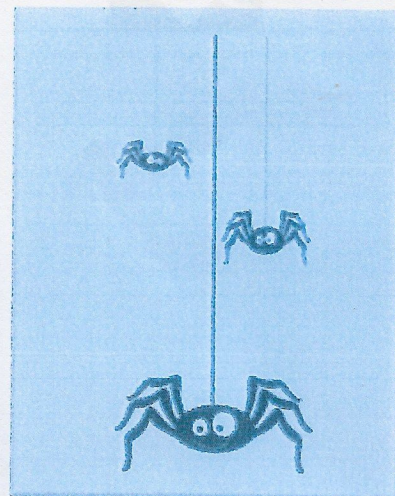
## Spiders

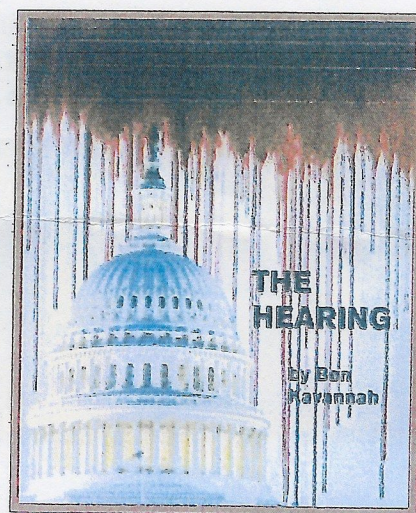
